Job Summary: Performs a variety of law enforcement activities including; patrol, investigation, community relations, narcotics control, and youth services for the City of Nixa's Police Department to ensure the safety and security of its residents.

Essential Job Functions

An employee in this position may be called upon to do any or all of the following essential duties:

- Patrol area in a police vehicle to preserve law and order by discovering and/or preventing the commission of crimes and enforcing State and Municipal laws and Ordinances.
- Respond to calls and complaints involving criminal and civil situations such as assaults, automobile accidents, burglaries, domestic disturbances, fights, and robberies.
- Secure crime scenes and conduct preliminary investigations.
- Enforce traffic laws and ordinances by checking vehicle speed by radar or pacing, and issue warnings and citations when violations are observed/ prepare reports to document the facts of an incident and facilitate the apprehension, prosecution, and conviction of the perpetrator.
- Appear in court to present sworn testimony and evidence on behalf of the City or State.
- May serve in special assignments such as; D.A.R.E. officer who is responsible for drug and crime prevention efforts in the schools and specializes in youth services, Traffic Enforcement Officer with advanced training in accident investigation and reconstruction with emphasis in traffic law and enforcement.
- May serve as a special investigator or assistant to other local, regional, State, or Federal agency, in order to develop information and evidence, apprehend perpetrators, prepare cases for court, and/or provide evidence and testimony in court.
- May perform other public service activities such as providing training and information to community or neighborhood groups, schools, and churches.
- May assist with animal control activities.
- Effectively perform as a member of a team in carrying out the City's organizational development plan philosophy.
- Perform other tasks and duties assigned by supervisor.

Knowledge

- City of Nixa, State, Federal, and County ordinance statutes, codes, and regulations to be enforced, and relating to the rights of individuals.

- Standard law enforcement equipment, including batons, computers, radar radios, vehicles, and weapons.
- Occupational hazards.

Skills

- Good oral and written communications.
- Establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with other officers, civilian staff, and members of the public.
- Interpreting complex statutes, ordinances, regulations, and guidelines.
- Performing patrol, investigation, and special assignment activities.
- Successfully complete the Dept. Field Training Program.
- Establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with other staff and members of the public.

Abilities

- Sight, hearing, smelling and speech, coordinated use of both arms, hands, legs, and feet at once, bending, frequent, and rapid lateral movements over various terrain.
- Lifting, carrying, stooping, superior strength with ability to push and pull up to 100 pounds and lift up to 50 pounds from the ground to 3 feet in height unassisted, changing of physical location.
- Mentally analyze a situation, solve problems, and make decisions under pressure in area of responsibility.
- Work indoors with heating and cooling regulated. May be exposed to extreme weather conditions, dust, and/or pollen. Available to work varied hours including some evenings and weekends.
