NOTICE TO ALL APPLICANTS

The Grinnell Police Department appreciates your interest in our organization. We will be conducting an open process, with no current application deadline, until such time that a viable list of candidates can be submitted to the Grinnell Civil Service Commission for interview and hiring list certification.

All non-certified applicants will be required to take the physical agility test. We are accepting physical agility test scores from other agencies within the time period of March 1, 2020 through March 1, 2021. Applicants who have a passing, currently valid P .O.S.T. test score, which is not over 1 year old by the date of testing, will not be required to re-test. Candidates who have taken the maximum number of P.O.S.T. tests will have to stand on their highest score.

In order for you to plan for this process, the following illustrates the sequence of events that will take place toward the certification of a hiring list. Please note that social distancing measures will be enforced for the physical fitness and P.O.S.T. testing. Interviews will be scheduled using Zoom or a similar web-based video conference system.

- Acceptance of applications Open until otherwise determined
- Physical fitness and P.O.S.T test
- Department Oral Board and Command Oral Board interviews
- Conditional Offer of Employment (Contingent on successful passing of)
 - Polygraph Examination; Background Investigation;
 - Medical Examination; Psychological Examination
 - o Passing of Civil Service interview and placement on Civil Service Hiring List
- Appointment Two openings current exist
